Meeting Minutes

September 23, 2007

I. Call to Order – President Dave Comparette called to order the regular meeting of the **Lake Shore Corvettes** at 7:20 PM on Sept. 23, 2007. 18 members were present.

II. Approval of Minutes – copies of the minutes from August's meeting were given to members present, and were approved as written.

III. Governor's Report-Ric Keller

- a. NCCC director Peggy Stephens attended our *Corvettes for the Troops Show*, and said she had a very nice time. We did have an e-mail complaint from a member of Flag City Corvettes stating that only our club's cars won all the prizes (not true). We will bring this complaint up at the Governor's meeting, and also discuss whether hosting club members should enter or be judged at their own shows.
